A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to reimbursing public institutions of higher education for
- 3 tuition and fee exemptions for certain military personnel and their

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 54.341, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (o) to read as follows:
- 8 (o) Based on the amount of any legislative appropriations
- 9 made to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board for the
- 10 purpose and any other available funds that the coordinating board
- 11 applies to the purpose, the coordinating board shall reimburse an
- 12 <u>institution of higher education for all or a portion of the cost to</u>
- 13 the institution in providing exemptions under this section. If the
- 14 amount appropriated is insufficient to fully reimburse each
- 15 institution under this subsection for a state fiscal year, the
- 16 coordinating board shall provide the reimbursements based on the
- 17 proportionate costs to the institutions in providing the
- 18 exemptions. The coordinating board may use a reasonable portion of
- 19 the money appropriated to the coordinating board for the purpose of
- 20 this subsection, not to exceed one percent, for the costs of
- 21 administering this subsection. The coordinating board by rule
- 22 shall establish procedures for an institution to:
- 23 (1) request reimbursement under this subsection; and
- 24 (2) submit data requested by the coordinating board as

- 1 necessary to administer this subsection.
- 2 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 3 beginning with tuition and fee exemptions granted for the 2013 fall
- 4 semester.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
