A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-21 relating to the authority of a water and sewer utility to collect 1-22 1-23 voluntary contributions on behalf of a local library.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Sections 13.143(a), (b), and (d), Water Code, 1-25 are amended to read as follows:

1-26 (a) A utility may implement as part of its billing process a program under which the utility collects from its customers a voluntary contribution, including a voluntary membership or subscription fee, on behalf of <u>a local library</u>, a volunteer fire 1-27 1-28 1-29 department, or an emergency medical service. 1-30

(b) A utility that collects contributions under this section shall provide each customer at the time that the customer first becomes a customer, and at least annually thereafter, a 1-31 1-32 1-33 1-34 written statement:

1-35 (1) describing the procedure by which the customer may 1-36 make a contribution with the customer's bill payment;

1-37 (2) designating the <u>local library</u>, volunteer fire department, or emergency medical service to which the utility will 1-38 1-39 deliver the contribution;

(3) 1-40 informing the customer that a contribution is 1-41 voluntary; and

1-42 (4)describing the deductibility of the status contribution under federal income tax law. 1-43

1 - 44(d) The utility shall promptly deliver contributions that 1-45 it collects under this section to the designated local library, volunteer fire department, or emergency medical service, except that the utility may keep from the contributions an amount equal to 1-46 1-47 1-48 the lesser of:

1-49 (1)the utility's expenses in administering the 1-50 contribution program; or

the 1-51 (2) five percent of amount collected as 1-52 contributions.

1-53 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-54 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-55 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-56 1-57 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
