1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to funding state highway markers.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Sections 225.021(b) and (c), Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:

- (b) The department \underline{shall} [\underline{may}] accept a grant or donation \underline{made} to assist in financing the construction and maintenance of a \underline{marker} .
- (c) The department <u>may not</u> [<u>is not required to</u>] design, construct, or erect a marker under this subchapter unless a grant or donation of funds is made to the department to cover the cost of the design, construction, and erection of the marker.

1-30 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-31 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-32 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-33 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-34 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
