## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the responsibility for keeping fire-fighting equipment
- 3 furnished to a volunteer fire department by a county in good working
- 4 order.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 352.005(e), Local Government Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (e) The <u>petitioner</u> [<del>county</del>] shall keep the fire-fighting
- 9 equipment in good working order, [and] make all necessary repairs
- 10 or replacements, and provide [. The commissioners court shall
- 11 determine if a repair or replacement is necessary and shall require
- 12 that repair work, including labor and materials for repairs [, be
- 13 provided as much as possible by the court's shops that it
- 14 designates]. The commissioners court may provide the petitioner
- 15 with at least one emergency unit of fire-fighting equipment to be
- 16 used while the regular unit is being repaired or replaced. The
- 17 commissioners court may use an available truck or other equipment
- 18 if it is unable to acquire a new truck or equipment for the purpose
- 19 of building or equipping the fire-fighting equipment.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
