4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 551.402, Transportation Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	Sec. 551.402. REGISTRATION NOT AUTHORIZED. (a) The Texas
8	Department of <u>Motor Vehicles</u> [Transportation] may not register a
9	golf cart for operation on a public highway regardless of whether
10	any alteration has been made to the golf cart.
11	(b) The <u>Texas Department of Motor Vehicles</u> [department] may
12	issue license plates for a golf cart [only] as authorized by
13	Subsection (c) [Section 504.510].
14	(c) The Texas Department of Motor Vehicles shall by rule
15	establish a procedure to issue the license plates to be used for
16	operation in accordance with Sections 551.403 and 551.404.
17	(d) The Texas Department of Motor Vehicles may charge a fee
18	not to exceed \$10 for the cost of the license plate.
19	SECTION 2. Section 551.404, Transportation Code, is amended
20	by amending Subsection $(a-1)$ and adding Subsection $(a-2)$ to read as
21	follows:
22	(a-1) In addition to the operation authorized by Section
23	551.403, the commissioners court of a county <u>described by</u>
24	Subsection (a-2) [that borders or contains a portion of the

No. 719 Guadalupe River and contains a part of a barrier island that borders 1 the Gulf of Mexico] may allow an operator to operate a golf cart or 2 3 utility vehicle on all or part of a public highway that: 4 (1)is located in the unincorporated area of the 5 county; and 6 (2) has a speed limit of not more than 35 miles per 7 hour. 8 (a-2) Subsection (a-1) applies only to a county that: 9 (1) borders or contains a portion of the Red River; (2) borders or contains a portion of the Guadalupe 10 River and contains a part of a barrier island that borders the Gulf 11 12 of Mexico; or 13 (3) is adjacent to a county described by Subdivision 14 (2) and: 15 (A) has a population of less than 30,000; and 16 (B) contains a part of a barrier island that 17 borders the Gulf of Mexico. SECTION 3. Section 504.510, Transportation 18 Code, is 19 repealed. SECTION 4. Not later than December 31, 2013, the Texas 20 Department of Motor Vehicles shall establish a procedure for the 21 issuance of license plates for golf carts to be used for operation 22 23 public highway, as required by Section 551.402(c), on a 24 Transportation Code, as added by this Act. 25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 27
