A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to legislative budget sessions in even-numbered years and
- 3 to reports of political contributions accepted during a budget
- 4 session.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 301.001, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 301.001. TIME OF MEETING. (a) In each odd-numbered
- 9 year, the [The] legislature shall convene in regular session at 12
- 10 noon on the second Tuesday in January [of each odd-numbered year].
- 11 (b) In each even-numbered year, the legislature shall
- 12 convene in budget session at 12 noon on the third Tuesday in April.
- SECTION 2. Section 317.003(a), Government Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (a) The governor or Legislative Budget Board may make a
- 16 proposal at any time except during a [regular or special] session of
- 17 the legislature. A proposal may apply to an appropriation that has
- 18 been made for any specified fiscal year that has not ended at the
- 19 time the proposal is made.
- SECTION 3. The heading to Section 254.0391, Election Code,
- 21 is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 254.0391. REPORT DURING BUDGET OR SPECIAL
- 23 [LECISLATIVE] SESSION OF LEGISLATURE.
- SECTION 4. Section 254.0391, Election Code, is amended by

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- 1 adding Subsection (a-1) and amending Subsection (d) to read as
- 2 follows:
- 3 <u>(a-1)</u> A statewide officeholder, a member of the
- 4 legislature, or a specific-purpose committee for supporting,
- 5 opposing, or assisting a statewide officeholder or member of the
- 6 legislature, or a candidate for statewide office or the legislature
- 7 or a specific-purpose committee for supporting or opposing the
- 8 candidate, that accepts a political contribution during a budget
- 9 session of the legislature shall report the contribution to the
- 10 commission not later than the 30th day after the date of final
- 11 adjournment.
- 12 (d) A report is not required under this section if a person
- 13 covered by Subsection (a) or (a-1) is required to file another
- 14 report under this chapter not later than the 10th day after the date
- 15 a report required under this section would be due.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect January 1, 2014, but only
- 17 if the constitutional amendment proposed by the 83rd Legislature,
- 18 Regular Session, 2013, providing for legislative budget sessions in
- 19 even-numbered years is approved by the voters. If that proposed
- 20 constitutional amendment is not approved by the voters, this Act
- 21 has no effect.
