- 9 designed for persons eligible under Section 19.005 and ensure that
- 10 those programs, such as GED and ESL, are integrated with an applied
- 11 vocational context leading to employment;
- 12 (1-a) develop vocational training programs
- 13 specifically designed for persons eligible under Section 19.005 and
- 14 prioritize the programs that result in certification or licensure,
- 15 considering the impact that a previous felony conviction has on the
- 16 ability to secure certification, licensure, and employment;
- 17 (1-b) continually assess job markets in this state and
- 18 update, augment, and expand the vocational training programs
- 19 <u>developed under Subdivision (1-a) as necessary to provide relevant</u>
- 20 and marketable skills to students; and
- 21 (2) coordinate educational programs and services in
- 22 the department with those provided by other state agencies, by
- 23 political subdivisions, and by persons who provide programs and
- 24 services under contract.
