board of the appraisal district until: 1 2 (1) the second anniversary of the date the person ceased to be a member or officer, if the appraisal district is 3 4 established for a county having a population of more than 100,000 but not more than 250,000; or 5 6 (2) the fourth anniversary of the date the person 7 ceased to be a member or officer, if the appraisal district is established for a county having a population of more than 250,000. 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2013. 13
