 1-17 AN ACT

1-18 relating to the dissemination of information regarding employment  
 1-19 opportunities in this state to secondary school students.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 302, Labor Code, is  
 1-22 amended by adding Section 302.014 to read as follows:

1-23 Sec. 302.014. EMPLOYMENT INFORMATION FOR SECONDARY SCHOOL  
 1-24 STUDENTS. (a) The commission shall provide the Texas Education  
 1-25 Agency with information at least each quarter regarding current and  
 1-26 projected employment opportunities in this state, disaggregated by  
 1-27 county or other appropriate region.

1-28 (b) The Texas Education Agency shall provide the  
 1-29 information obtained under Subsection (a) to school districts for  
 1-30 use in local planning and implementation of career and technical  
 1-31 education and training programs.

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
