- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 401.022, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 401.022. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "unavailable"
- 8 means, with respect to the governor or a person authorized to act as
- 9 governor under the Texas Constitution or this subchapter:
- 10 (1) not able to exercise the powers and discharge the
- 11 duties of the office of governor for any reason specified in the
- 12 Texas Constitution:
- (2) being physically located outside the territorial
- 14 boundaries of the contiguous 48 states of the continental United
- 15 States;
- 16 (3) being physically located outside the state but
- 17 inside the territorial boundaries of the contiguous 48 states of
- 18 the continental United States if the governor or person authorized
- 19 to act as governor gives notice under Section 401.0225 that the
- 20 governor or person authorized to act as governor will not rely on
- 21 electronic communication while absent from the state; or
- 22 <u>(4) being physically located outside this state for</u>
- 23 more than seven consecutive days.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 401, Government Code, is

- 1 amended by adding Section 401.0225 to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 401.0225. NOTICE OF UNAVAILABILITY. The governor or a
- 3 person authorized to act as governor shall reasonably notify the
- 4 next person in the line of succession under the Texas Constitution
- 5 or this subchapter when the governor or person authorized to act as
- 6 governor will become unavailable as described by Section
- 7 <u>401.022(2)</u>, (3), or (4).
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the date on which the
- 9 constitutional amendment proposed by the 83rd Legislature, Regular
- 10 Session, 2013, providing that the governor, and the lieutenant
- 11 governor when acting as governor, retain executive authority unless
- 12 unavailable as provided by law is approved by the voters. If that
- 13 amendment is not approved by the voters, this Act has no effect.
