- 5 SECTION 1. Section 157.162(b), Family Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b) A finding that the respondent is not in contempt does
- 8 not preclude the court from awarding the petitioner court costs and
- 9 reasonable attorney's fees or ordering any other enforcement
- 10 remedy, including rendering a money judgment, posting a bond or
- 11 other security, or withholding income.
- SECTION 2. Sections 157.162(d) and (e), Family Code, are
- 13 repealed.
- 14 SECTION 3. The repeal by this Act of Sections 157.162(d) and
- 15 (e), Family Code, applies to a hearing to enforce an order in a suit
- 16 affecting the parent-child relationship that commences on or after
- 17 the effective date of this Act. A hearing that commences before the
- 18 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 19 date the hearing commenced, and the former law is continued in
- 20 effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
