## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a security services contractor's lien.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 5, Property Code, is amended by
5	adding Chapter 66 to read as follows:
6	CHAPTER 66. SECURITY SERVICES CONTRACTOR'S LIEN
7	Sec. 66.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
8	(1) "Security services" means the activities listed in
9	Section 1702.102(a), Occupations Code.
10	(2) "Security services contractor" has the meaning
11	assigned by Section 1702.002, Occupations Code.
12	Sec. 66.002. LIEN. A security services contractor who
13	provides security services for a commercial entity under a contract
14	with the commercial entity has a lien under this chapter for the
15	amount owed under the contract.
16	Sec. 66.003. PROPERTY SUBJECT TO LIEN. The lien attaches to
17	the premises for which the security services contractor provided
18	security services under the contract, if owned by the commercial
19	entity that entered into the contract, and to the personal property
20	owned by the commercial entity and located on those premises.
21	Sec. 66.004. SECURING LIEN. A security services contractor

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who has not been paid for security services provided and who wants

to claim a lien under this chapter must, not later than the 30th day

after the date the indebtedness accrues:

- 1 (1) file with the county clerk of the county in which
- 2 the premises are located a copy of an account of the services with
- 3 an affidavit verifying the account by the party making the account;
- 4 and
- 5 (2) serve a copy of the account and affidavit on the
- 6 commercial entity that owns the property or the entity's agent,
- 7 <u>receiver, or trustee.</u>
- 8 Sec. 66.005. DURATION OF LIEN. A lien created under this
- 9 chapter expires on the first anniversary of the date the lien is
- 10 secured, unless the security services contractor has sued to
- 11 foreclose the lien.
- 12 Sec. 66.006. RELEASE OF CLAIM OR LIEN. (a) When a debt for
- 13 security services is satisfied, the security services contractor
- 14 shall, not later than the 10th day after the date the security
- 15 <u>services contractor receives a written request, provide to the</u>
- 16 requesting person a release of the indebtedness and any lien
- 17 claimed, to the extent of the indebtedness paid.
- 18 (b) A release of lien must be in a form that permits the
- 19 instrument to be filed of record.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by Chapter 66, Property
- 21 Code, as added by this Act, applies only to security services
- 22 provided under a contract entered into or renewed on or after the
- 23 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
