A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the frequency of water audits by certain retail public
- 3 utilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 16.0121(b), (c), and (f), Water Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A [Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), a] retail
- 8 public utility providing potable water [that receives from the
- 9 board financial assistance] shall perform and file with the board
- 10 an annual water audit computing the utility's system water loss
- 11 during the preceding year.
- 12 (c) The board shall develop appropriate methodologies and
- 13 submission dates for a water audit required under Subsection (b)
- 14 [or (b-1)] for the following categories of retail public utilities:
- 15 (1) retail public utilities serving populations of
- 16 100,000 or more;
- 17 (2) retail public utilities serving populations of
- 18 50,000 or more but less than 100,000;
- 19 (3) retail public utilities serving populations of
- 20 more than 10,000 but less than 50,000; and
- 21 (4) retail public utilities serving populations of
- 22 10,000 or less.
- 23 (f) The board shall compile the information included in the
- 24 water audits required by Subsection [Subsections] (b) [and (b-1)]

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- 1 according to category of retail public utility and according to
- 2 regional water planning area. The regional planning group for a
- 3 regional planning area shall use the information to identify
- 4 appropriate water management strategies in the development of a
- 5 regional water plan under Section 16.053.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 16.0121(b-1), Water Code, is repealed.
- 7 SECTION 3. (a) The changes in law made by this Act do not
- 8 affect the date on which a retail public utility subject to Section
- 9 2, Chapter 1041 (H.B. 3090), Acts of the 82nd Legislature, Regular
- 10 Session, 2011, is required to submit an annual water audit required
- 11 by Section 16.0121, Water Code.
- 12 (b) Not later than May 1, 2015, a retail public utility
- 13 that, immediately before the effective date of this Act, is subject
- 14 to Section 16.0121(b-1), Water Code, shall submit its initial
- 15 annual water audit required by Section 16.0121, Water Code, as
- 16 amended by this Act. The initial water audit shall compute the
- 17 utility's most recent annual system water loss.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
