H.B. No. 867

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT  
2 relating to the appointment of certain representatives to certain  
3 regional water planning groups.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 16.053(c), Water Code, is amended to  
6 read as follows:

7 (c) No later than 60 days after the designation of the  
8 regions under Subsection (b), the board shall designate  
9 representatives within each regional water planning area to serve  
10 as the initial coordinating body for planning. The initial  
11 coordinating body may then designate additional representatives to  
12 serve on the regional water planning group. The initial  
13 coordinating body shall designate additional representatives if  
14 necessary to ensure adequate representation from the interests  
15 comprising that region, including the public, counties,  
16 municipalities, industries, agricultural interests, environmental  
17 interests, small businesses, electric generating utilities, river  
18 authorities, water districts, and water utilities. The regional  
19 water planning group shall maintain adequate representation from  
20 those interests. In addition, the groundwater conservation  
21 districts located in each management area, as defined by Section  
22 36.001, located in the regional water planning area shall appoint  
23 one representative of a groundwater conservation district located  
24 in the management area and in the regional water planning area to

1 serve on the regional water planning group. In addition, the  
2 commissioners court of each county located in Regional Water  
3 Planning Area D, as the area's boundaries existed on September 1,  
4 2013, may appoint one representative of the county to the regional  
5 water planning group in that area. In addition, representatives of  
6 the board, the Parks and Wildlife Department, and the Department of  
7 Agriculture shall serve as ex officio members of each regional  
8 water planning group.

9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
