## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to certain requirements before completing mold
- 3 remediation work.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 1958.152, Occupations
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1958.152. REMEDIATION WORK PLAN AND AGREEMENT;
- 8 CONSUMER INFORMATION.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 1958.152, Occupations Code, is amended
- 10 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1) and (c) to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (a) A license holder who intends to perform mold remediation
- 13 shall prepare a work plan providing instructions for the
- 14 remediation efforts to be performed for the mold remediation
- 15 project.
- 16 <u>(a-1)</u> Before the mold remediation begins, the [The] license
- 17 holder must:
- 18 <u>(1)</u> [shall] provide the work plan and a mold
- 19 information sheet to the client; and
- 20 (2) obtain a signed agreement with the property owner
- 21 concerning the terms and scope of the mold remediation project
- 22 [before the mold remediation begins].
- 23 <u>(c) The department shall prescribe the form and content of</u>
- 24 the mold information sheet described by Subsection (a-1)(1).

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- 1 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 2 1958.152, Occupations Code, applies only to a mold remediation
- 3 project commenced on or after the effective date of this Act. A mold
- 4 remediation project commenced before the effective date of this Act
- 5 is governed by the law in effect when the project commenced, and the
- 6 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 4. The executive commissioner of the Health and
- 8 Human Services Commission shall adopt rules to implement Section
- 9 1958.152(c), Occupations Code, as added by this Act, not later than
- 10 December 1, 2013.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
