## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the requirement that certain governmental bodies
- 3 broadcast meetings on the Internet.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 551.128, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (b) and (c) and adding Subsections (b-1) and
- 7 (b-2) to read as follows:
- 8 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1) and subject
- 9 [Subject] to the requirements of this section, a governmental body
- 10 may broadcast an open meeting over the Internet.
- 11 (b-1) The governing body of a county, public school
- 12 district, or home-rule municipality with a population of 50,000 or
- 13 more shall:
- 14 (1) broadcast each regularly scheduled open meeting
- 15 over the Internet; and
- 16 (2) make available archived video and audio of each
- 17 meeting broadcast over the Internet under this subsection.
- 18 (b-2) A governmental body described by Subsection (b-1) may
- 19 broadcast a regularly scheduled open meeting and make available
- 20 <u>archived video and audio of a meeting over an existing Internet</u>
- 21 site, including a publicly accessible video-sharing or social
- 22 networking site. The governmental body is not required to establish
- 23 a separate Internet site and provide access to broadcasts from that
- 24 site. The governmental body is still subject to the notice

- 1 requirements under Subsection (c) in relation to the site at which
- 2 the meetings are available.
- 3 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (b-2), a [A]
- 4 governmental body that broadcasts a meeting over the Internet shall
- 5 establish an Internet site and provide access to the broadcast from
- 6 that site. The governmental body shall provide on the Internet site
- 7 the same notice of the meeting that the governmental body is
- 8 required to post under Subchapter C. The notice on the Internet must
- 9 be posted within the time required for posting notice under
- 10 Subchapter C.
- 11 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 12 an open meeting held on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 13 open meeting that is held before the effective date of this Act is
- 14 governed by the law in effect on the date of the open meeting, and
- 15 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
