- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 503.068, Transportation Code, is amended
- 7 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (b) A person may not use a metal dealer's license plate or
- 10 dealer's temporary tag on:
- 11 (1) a service or work vehicle, except as provided by
- 12 Subsection (b-1); or
- 13 (2) a commercial vehicle that is carrying a load.
- 14 (b-1) An independent motor vehicle dealer or an employee of
- 15 an independent motor vehicle dealer may use a metal dealer's
- 16 license plate on a service or work vehicle used to transport a
- 17 vehicle in the dealer's inventory to or from a point of sale. This
- 18 subsection does not authorize a person to operate a service or work
- 19 <u>vehicle as a tow truck, as defined by Section 2308.002, Occupations</u>
- 20 Code, without a license or permit required by Chapter 2308,
- 21 Occupations Code.
- 22 SECTION 2. The Texas Department of Motor Vehicles shall
- 23 adopt rules consistent with Section 503.068, Transportation Code,
- 24 as amended by this Act, not later than December 1, 2013.
