A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to licensing and regulation of certain facilities providing personal care to persons who are elderly or disabled. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 260.002, Health and Safety Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 260.002. EXEMPTIONS. This chapter does not apply to: 7 (1) a person that is required to be licensed under 8 Chapter 142, 242, 246, 247, or 252; 9 [a person that is exempt from licensing under 10 (2) Section 142.003(a)(19), 242.003(3), or 247.004(4); 11 12 [(3)] a hotel as defined by Section 156.001, Tax Code; 13 (3) [(4)] a retirement community; 14 (4) [(5)] a monastery or convent; (5) [(6)] a child-care facility as defined by Section 15 42.002, Human Resources Code; 16 (6) $\left[\frac{(7)}{1}\right]$ a family violence shelter center as defined 17 by Section 51.002, Human Resources Code; or 18 (7) [(8)] a sorority or fraternity house or other 19 20 dormitory associated with an institution of higher education. 21 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding Sections 260.004 and 260.005, Health and Safety Code, a person that is exempt from licensing under 22 Section 142.003(a)(19), 242.003(3), or 247.004(4), Health and 23 Safety Code, and that operates a boarding home facility on the 24

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effective date of this Act in a county or municipality that requires a person to obtain a permit to operate the facility in the county or municipality is not required to obtain that permit until January 1, 2014.
