A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to reimbursement rates for certain therapy services
 3 provided to Medicaid recipients.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 32.028, Human Resources Code, is amended 6 by adding Subsection (o) to read as follows:
- 7 (o) The executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 8 Services Commission, in adopting reasonable rules and standards
- 9 governing the determination of rates paid for physical,
- 10 occupational, or speech therapy services under the medical
- 11 assistance program, shall ensure that providers holding the same
- 12 professional license and located in the same geographical region
- 13 <u>are reimbursed for the provision of a particular service at an equal</u>
- 14 rate, regardless of:

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- 15 (1) the setting in which the service is provided; or
- 16 (2) whether the provider practices as a sole
- 17 practitioner or is associated with or employed by another provider.
- 18 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 19 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 20 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 21 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 22 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 23 waiver or authorization is granted.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
