A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the amount of a chargeback for unemployment  
3 compensation benefits paid to a person who is partially unemployed.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 204.022, Labor Code, is amended by  
6 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

7 (a-1) Benefits computed on benefit wage credits of an  
8 employee may not be charged to the account of an employer if the  
9 employee continued to work the employee's customary hours for the  
10 employer when the employee's benefit year began. This subsection  
11 does not apply to a claim for unemployment benefits made under  
12 Chapter 215.

13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only  
14 to a claim for unemployment compensation benefits filed with the  
15 Texas Workforce Commission on or after the effective date of this  
16 Act. A claim filed before the effective date of this Act is  
17 governed by the law in effect on the date the claim was filed, and  
18 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
