## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to excepting certain vehicle location information from

- 3 required disclosure under the public information law.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 552.108, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) Detailed, aggregated information held by a law
- 8 enforcement agency or prosecutor that relates to the location of a
- 9 vehicle used for law enforcement is excepted from the requirements
- 10 <u>of Section 552.021 if:</u>

- 11 (1) the information requested:
- (A) would directly or indirectly reveal the
- 13 physical location of or route used by more than one peace officer or
- 14 vehicles operated by more than one peace officer or in relation to
- 15 more than one incident; and
- 16 (B) relates to more than a 24-hour period; and
- 17 (2) the law enforcement agency determines that the
- 18 release of the information may create a hazard to a peace officer,
- 19 the public, or another person.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
