- 5 SECTION 1. Section 5, Article 42.141, Code of Criminal
- 6 Procedure, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) A person who provides direct battering intervention
- 8 counseling services to a batterer for a program located in a county
- 9 with a population of more than 50,000 must be licensed as a social
- 10 worker, professional counselor, marriage and family therapist, or
- 11 psychologist or a licensed physician who is board certified in
- 12 psychiatry.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2014.
