- (q) The commissioners court of a county with a population of 8
- less than 200,000 in which a minor league hockey team is or has been 9
- located and in which a component institution of The University of 10
- Texas System is located may impose a tax as provided by Subsection 11
- 12 (a).

- SECTION 2. Section 352.003, Tax Code, is amended by adding 13
- 14 Subsection (r) to read as follows:
- (r) The tax rate in a county authorized to impose the tax 15
- 16 under Section 352.002(q) may not exceed two percent of the price
- paid for a room in a hotel. 17
- SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 352, Tax Code, is amended 18
- by adding Section 352.1038 to read as follows: 19
- Sec. 352.1038. USE OF REVENUE: CERTAIN COUNTIES CONTAINING 20
- 21 UNIVERSITIES. The revenue from a tax imposed under this chapter by
- a county authorized to impose the tax under Section 352.002(q) may 22
- 23 be used only to:
- 24 (1) operate, maintain, and improve a coliseum in the

- 1 county;
- 2 (2) advertise and conduct solicitations and
- 3 promotional programs to attract visitors to the coliseum; and
- 4 (3) maintain and improve infrastructure in the county
- 5 to improve traffic flow to the coliseum.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
