## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

| 5  | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:             |
| 6  | SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws         |
| 7  | Code, is amended by adding Chapter 8413 to read as follows:         |
| 8  | CHAPTER 8413. WILLOW POINT MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT OF            |
| 9  | FORT BEND AND WALLER COUNTIES                                       |
| 10 | SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS                                    |
| 11 | Sec. 8413.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "district'              |
| 12 | means the Willow Point Municipal Utility District of Fort Bend and  |
| 13 | Waller Counties.  |
| 14 | Sec. 8413.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a                |
| 15 | municipal utility district in Fort Bend and Waller Counties created |
| 16 | under and essential to accomplish the purposes of Section 52(b)(3), |
| 17 | Article III, or Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.        |
| 18 | Sec. 8413.003. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAW. Except as                |
| 19 | otherwise provided by this chapter, Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, |
| 20 | apply to the district.  |
| 21 | [Sections 8413.004-8413.050 reserved for expansion]                 |
| 22 | SUBCHAPTER B. POWERS AND DUTIES                                     |
| 23 | Sec. 8413.051. ROAD PROJECTS. (a) The district may                  |
| 24 | construct, acquire, improve, maintain, or operate macadamized,      |

- 1 graveled, or paved roads or turnpikes, or improvements in aid of
- 2 those roads or turnpikes, inside the district.
- 3 (b) A road project must meet all applicable construction
- 4 standards, zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulations
- 5 of:
- 6 (1) each municipality in whose corporate limits or
- 7 <u>extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located; and</u>
- 8 (2) each county in which the district is located.
- 9 (c) The district may not undertake a road project unless
- 10 each municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial
- 11 jurisdiction the district is located consents by resolution.
- 12 Sec. 8413.052. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT
- 13 RESOLUTIONS. The district shall comply with all applicable
- 14 requirements of any resolution, adopted by the governing body of a
- 15 municipality, that consented to the creation of the district or to
- 16 the inclusion of land in the district.

- 18 SUBCHAPTER C. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS
- 19 Sec. 8413.101. TAX TO REPAY BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. The
- 20 district may impose a tax to pay the principal of or interest on
- 21 bonds issued under Section 8413.151.
- 22 [Sections 8413.102-8413.150 reserved for expansion]
- SUBCHAPTER D. BONDS
- Sec. 8413.151. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER
- 25 OBLIGATIONS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. (a) The district may issue bonds or
- 26 other obligations as provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to
- 27 finance the construction, maintenance, or operation of projects

- 1 under Section 8413.051.
- 2 (b) The district may not issue bonds or other obligations
- 3 secured wholly or partly by ad valorem taxation to finance projects
- 4 authorized by Section 8413.051 unless the issuance is approved by a
- 5 vote of a two-thirds majority of the voters in the district or of
- 6 the defined areas to be benefited by the project as provided by
- 7 Subchapter J, Chapter 54, Water Code, voting at an election called
- 8 for that purpose. The simple majority vote approval required by
- 9 Section 54.808(a), Water Code, does not apply to an election under
- 10 this subsection.
- 11 (c) Bonds or other obligations issued or incurred to finance
- 12 projects authorized by Section 8413.051 may not exceed one-fourth
- 13 of the assessed value of the real property in the district or the
- 14 <u>defined area as provided by Subchapter J, Chapter 54, Water Code.</u>
- 15 SECTION 2. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 16 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 17 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 18 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 19 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 20 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 21 Government Code.
- 22 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 23 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 24 Environmental Quality.
- 25 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 26 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 27 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of

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- 1 representatives within the required time.
- 2 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 3 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 4 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 5 and accomplished.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
