- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 1201, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1201.1025 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1201.1025. EXEMPTION FROM RETAILER'S LICENSE
- 8 REQUIREMENT. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, in any 12-month
- 9 period a person is exempt from holding a retailer's license as
- 10 required by Section 1201.101(b) if during that period the person
- 11 sells or offers to sell not more than three manufactured homes.
- 12 (b) The department by rule shall develop a form necessary
- 13 for a person to establish eligibility for the exemption provided by
- 14 this section.
- 15 (c) A person who is eligible for an exemption under this
- 16 section remains subject to the other applicable provisions of this
- 17 subchapter regarding the sale of manufactured homes.
- 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 19 to a sale of or an offer to sell manufactured homes on or after the
- 20 effective date of this Act. A sale of or an offer to sell
- 21 manufactured homes before that date is governed by the law in effect
- 22 on the date of the sale, and the former law is continued in effect
- 23 for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
