3	relating to certain offenses committed by certain students.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 37, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 37.023 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 37.023. REPORTS RELATING TO CERTAIN OFFENSES COMMITTED
8	BY CERTAIN STUDENTS. (a) In the manner required by the
9	commissioner and subject to Subsection (b), each school district
10	shall annually report to the commissioner information relating to
11	each offense that does not involve the use of a weapon:
12	(1) committed during school hours on school property
13	by a student who is younger than 12 years of age; and
14	(2) for which the student receives a citation.
15	(b) Conduct that must be reported under Subsection (a)
16	includes only conduct that:
17	(1) is not harassment as defined by Section 37.001;
18	(2) occurs between two students;
19	(3) is not violent;
20	(4) involves open-handed physical contact; and
21	(5) is not intended to cause harm and is playful.
22	(c) The report required under Subsection (a) must include:
23	(1) the offense committed by the student;
24	(2) the age and sex of the student;

- 1 (3) the race or ethnicity of the student;
- 2 (4) the grade level of the student; and
- 3 (5) the campus to which the student is assigned.
- 4 (d) The commissioner may adopt rules necessary to implement
- 5 this section.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014
- 7 school year.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
