- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 814, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 814.404 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 814.404. ASSIGNMENT OF DEATH BENEFIT FOR FUNERAL
- 8 SERVICES. (a) A beneficiary to whom a benefit is payable under
- 9 this subchapter may by assignment provide that part or all of the
- 10 benefit be paid in consideration for services provided in
- 11 connection with the death of the member directly to a funeral
- 12 <u>director or funeral establishment licensed under:</u>
- 13 (1) Chapter 651, Occupations Code; or
- 14 (2) the comparable law of another state.
- 15 (b) The board of trustees by rule may establish requirements
- 16 for forms, documentation, and procedures necessary for an effective
- 17 assignment under this section.
- 18 SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 814, Government Code, is
- 19 amended by adding Section 814.507 to read as follows:
- 20 <u>Sec. 814.507. ASSIGNMENT OF DEATH BENEFIT FOR FUNERAL</u>
- 21 SERVICES. (a) A beneficiary to whom a benefit is payable under
- 22 this subchapter may by assignment provide that part or all of the
- 23 benefit be paid in consideration for services provided in
- 24 connection with the death of the retiree directly to a funeral

- 1 <u>director or funeral establishment licensed under:</u>
- 2 (1) Chapter 651, Occupations Code; or
- 3 (2) the comparable law of another state.
- 4 (b) The board of trustees by rule may establish requirements
- 5 for forms, documentation, and procedures necessary for an effective
- 6 assignment under this section.
- 7 SECTION 3. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective
- 8 date of this Act, but not later than January 1, 2014, the board of
- 9 trustees of the Employees Retirement System of Texas shall adopt
- 10 rules to implement Sections 814.404 and 814.507, Government Code,
- 11 as added by this Act.
- 12 (b) The change in law made by this Act by the enactment of
- 13 Sections 814.404 and 814.507, Government Code, applies only to a
- 14 benefit that is payable on or after January 1, 2014. A benefit that
- 15 is payable before that date is governed by the law in effect
- 16 immediately before January 1, 2014, and the former law is continued
- 17 in effect for that purpose.
- 18 SECTION 4. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 19 section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
- 20 (b) Sections 814.404 and 814.507, Government Code, as added
- 21 by this Act, take effect January 1, 2014.
