- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 574.045(a) and (a-1), Health and Safety
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The court may authorize, in the following order of
- 8 priority, the transportation of a committed patient or a patient
- 9 detained under Section 573.022 or 574.023 to the designated mental
- 10 health facility by:
- 11 (1) a special officer for mental health assignment
- 12 certified under Section 1701.404, Occupations Code;
- 13 (2) the facility administrator of the designated
- 14 mental health facility, unless the administrator notifies the court
- 15 that facility personnel are not available to transport the patient;
- 16 (3) [a relative or other responsible person who has a
- 17 proper interest in the patient's welfare and who receives no
- 18 remuneration, except for actual and necessary expenses;
- 19  $\left[\frac{(4)}{a}\right]$  a representative of the local mental health
- 20 authority, who shall be reimbursed by the county, unless the
- 21 representative notifies the court that local mental health
- 22 authority personnel are not qualified to ensure the safety of the
- 23 patient during transport;
- 24 (4) [<del>(5)</del>] a qualified transportation service provider

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- 1 selected from the list established and maintained as required by
- 2 Section 574.0455 by the commissioners court of the county in which
- 3 the court authorizing the transportation is located; [or]
- 4 (5) [(6)] the sheriff or constable; or
- 5 (6) a relative or other responsible person who has a
- 6 proper interest in the patient's welfare and who receives no
- 7 remuneration, except for actual and necessary expenses.
- 8 (a-1) A person who under Subsection (a)(1), (2), or (5)
- 9  $[\frac{(6)}{(6)}]$  is authorized by the court to transport a person to a mental
- 10 health facility may contract with a qualified transportation
- 11 service provider that is included on the list established and
- 12 maintained as required by Section 574.0455 by the commissioners
- 13 court of the county in which the court is located to provide the
- 14 transportation authorized by the court.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 574, Health and Safety
- 16 Code, is amended by adding Section 574.0456 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 574.0456. TRANSPORTATION OF PATIENT TO ANOTHER
- 18 STATE. A person may not transport a patient to a mental health
- 19 <u>facility in another state for court-ordered inpatient mental health</u>
- 20 services under this chapter unless transportation to that facility
- 21 <u>is authorized by a court order.</u>
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
