- 2 access, how the applicant may obtain a paper copy of the handbook
- 3 described by Paragraph (A).
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 2.010, Family Code, is amended to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 Sec. 2.010. AIDS INFORMATION; POSTING ON INTERNET. The
- 7 [Materials providing information about acquired immune deficiency
- 8 syndrome (AIDS) and human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) shall be
- 9 prepared and provided to the clerk by the Texas] Department of State
- 10 Health <u>Services</u> [and] shall prepare and make available to the
- 11 public on its Internet website information about acquired immune
- 12 deficiency syndrome (AIDS) and human immunodeficiency virus (HIV).
- 13 The information must be designed to inform an applicant for a
- 14 marriage license [the applicants] about:
- 15 (1) the incidence and mode of transmission of AIDS and
- 16 HIV;
- 17 (2) the local availability of medical procedures,
- 18 including voluntary testing, designed to show or help show whether

- 2 license in an electronic form on the Internet website of the child
- 3 support division of the office of the attorney general or, for an
- 4 applicant who does not have Internet access, in paper copy form; [as
- 5 provided by Section 2.009(c)(5)] and
- 6 (2) [shall] contain information on:
- 7 $\underline{\text{(A)}} [\frac{\text{(1)}}{\text{)}}]$ conflict management;
- 8 (B) $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ communication skills;
- 9 $\underline{\text{(C)}}$ [\(\frac{\((3\)\)}{\(3\)\}] children and parenting
- 10 responsibilities; and
- (D) $\left[\frac{4}{4}\right]$ financial responsibilities.
- 12 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 13 an application for a marriage license submitted to a county clerk on
- 14 or after the effective date of this Act. An application for a
- 15 marriage license submitted before the effective date of this Act is
- 16 governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and the
- 17 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
