- 2 relating to the deadlines by which provisional ballots must be
- 3 processed and the state canvass must be conducted for certain

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 65.051, Election Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(a-1)</u> Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for an election held
- 9 on the date of the general election for state and county officers,
- 10 the early voting ballot board shall verify and count provisional
- 11 ballots as provided by this subchapter not later than the 13th day
- 12 after the date of the election.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 65.052, Election Code, is amended to
- 14 read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 65.052. DUTY OF VOTER REGISTRAR. The secretary of
- 16 state shall prescribe procedures by which the voter registrar of
- 17 the county in which a provisional ballot is cast shall provide
- 18 assistance to the early voting ballot board in executing its
- 19 authority under this subchapter. <u>In an election described by</u>
- 20 Section 65.051(a-1), the procedures must allow for seven calendar
- 21 days for the voter registrar to review a provisional voter's
- 22 eligibility.
- SECTION 3. Section 67.003, Election Code, is amended by
- 24 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as

- 1 follows:
- 2 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) or (c), each local
- 3 canvassing authority shall convene to conduct the local canvass at
- 4 the time set by the canvassing authority's presiding officer not
- 5 earlier than the eighth day or later than the 11th day after
- 6 election day.
- 7 (c) In an election described by Section 65.051(a-1), the
- 8 time for the local canvass may be set not later than the 14th day
- 9 after election day.
- SECTION 4. Section 67.012(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (a) The governor shall conduct the state canvass [not
- 13 earlier than the 15th or later than the 30th day after election day]
- 14 at the time set by the secretary of state:
- 15 (1) not earlier than the 15th or later than the 30th
- 16 day after election day; or
- 17 (2) for an election described by Section 65.051(a-1),
- 18 not earlier than the 18th or later than the 33rd day after election
- 19 <u>day</u>.
- 20 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
