## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

H.B. No. 988

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the definition of a lock for purposes of the regulation
3	of certain private security companies and occupations.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 1702.002, Occupations Code, is amended
6	by adding Subdivision (13-a) to read as follows:
7	(13-a) "Lock" means a fastening device that:
8	(A) is used to secure, regulate, activate, or
9	control a door, gate, drawer, cabinet, safe, or automobile by means
10	of a mechanical or electric device, including a latch, bolt, key,
11	transmitter, card-reader, keypad, or proximity key fob; and
12	(B) is not monitored by security personnel or
13	services and does not send a signal to which law enforcement or
14	emergency services respond.
15	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

19 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
