- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 56.006, Education Code,
- is amended to read as follows: 8

- FINANCIAL] ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS FOR VETERANS AND FAMILIES; TRACKING 10
- ACADEMIC PROGRESS. 11
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 56.006, Education Code, is amended by
- amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as 13
- 14 follows:

- Each institution of higher education shall ensure that 15 (a)
- 16 one or more persons employed by the institution is trained:
- 17 (1)in understanding state and federal student
- financial assistance programs available to military veterans or 18
- their family members, especially programs specifically applicable 19
- 20 to military veterans or their family members; [and]
- 21 in assisting military veterans and eligible family
- members in understanding and obtaining the benefits available under 22
- 23 those programs; and
- 24 (3) in tracking, through the electronic auditing

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- 1 system as described by Subsection (a-1), the academic progress of
- 2 military veterans or family members of veterans receiving student
- 3 financial assistance, in verifying the information provided by the
- 4 system, and in providing guidance in understanding and using the
- 5 information.
- 6 (a-1) Each institution of higher education shall adopt and
- 7 maintain an electronic auditing system to verify the enrollment and
- 8 completion of courses that count toward the degree plan of military
- 9 veterans or family members of veterans receiving student financial
- 10 assistance. The electronic auditing system must, through the
- 11 institution's Internet website, allow a student described by this
- 12 subsection to track the student's progress towards completing the
- 13 student's degree plan.
- 14 SECTION 3. Each public institution of higher education in
- 15 this state shall implement the electronic auditing system as
- 16 required by Section 56.006, Education Code, as amended by this Act,
- 17 beginning with the 2014 fall semester.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
