4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 33.021, Penal Code, is amended by

6 amending Subsection (f) and adding Subsection (f-1) to read as

7 follows:

8 (f) An offense under Subsection (b) is a felony of the third

9 degree, except that the offense is a felony of the second degree if

10 the minor is younger than 14 years of age or is an individual whom

11 the actor believes to be younger than 14 years of age at the time of

12 the commission of the offense.

13 (f-1) An offense under Subsection (c) is a felony of the

14 second degree, except that the minimum term of imprisonment for the

15 offense is increased to five years if the actor, after soliciting

16 the minor on the actor's own behalf, travels or attempts to travel

17 any distance with the intent to meet the minor.

18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only

19 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.

20 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is

21 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,

22 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For

23 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the

24 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred

- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
