A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to access to birth records of certain adopted children.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 192.008, Health and Safety Code, 5 amended by adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:

6 (g) If an adult adoptee who does not know the identity of one or both parents listed on the person's original birth certificate 7 applies for access to the person's original birth certificate, the 8 9 state registrar shall perform a search of reasonably available death records to determine if each parent named on the original 10 11 birth certificate whose identity is unknown to the adoptee is 12 deceased. Upon confirmation that each parent named on the original birth certificate whose identity is unknown to the adoptee is 13 14 deceased, the registrar shall provide to the person a noncertified copy of the person's original birth certificate without a court 15 16 order.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to an 17 application for an original birth certificate filed on or after the 18 effective date of this Act, regardless of whether the suit for 19 adoption was filed before, on, or after the effective date of this 20 21 Act. An application for an original birth certificate filed before 22 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on 23 the date the application was filed, and the former law is continued 24 in effect for that purpose.

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
