## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to venue for the offense of a parent contributing to a

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.093(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b) The attendance officer or other appropriate school
- 8 official shall file a complaint against the parent in:
- 9 (1) the constitutional county court of the county in
- 10 which the parent resides or in which the school is located, if the
- 11 county has a population of 1.75 million or more;
- 12 (2) a justice court <u>designated to hear cases arising</u>
- 13 <u>under this section</u> [of any precinct] in the county in which the
- 14 parent resides or in which the school is located, or if no justice
- 15 court is designated, a justice court of any precinct in the county
- in which the parent resides or in which the school is located; or
- 17 (3) a municipal court of the municipality in which the
- 18 parent resides or in which the school is located.
- 19 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
- 20 25.093, Education Code, apply only to an offense committed on or
- 21 after the effective date of this Act. For purposes of this section,
- 22 an offense is committed before the effective date of this Act if any
- 23 element of the offense occurs before that date. An offense
- 24 committed before the effective date of this Act is covered by the

- 1 law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 2 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
