## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the prepaid wireless 9-1-1 emergency services fee;

- 3 clarifying the applicability of the fee.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 771.0712(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) To ensure that all 9-1-1 agencies under Section 418.051,
- 8 Government Code, are adequately funded, [beginning on June 1,
- 9  $\frac{2010_{7}}{}$ ] a prepaid wireless 9-1-1 emergency services fee of two
- 10 percent of the purchase price of each prepaid wireless
- 11 telecommunications service purchased by any method[ $_{ au}$ ] shall be
- 12 collected by the seller from the consumer at the time of each retail
- 13 transaction of prepaid wireless telecommunications service
- 14 occurring in this state and remitted to the comptroller consistent
- 15 with Chapter 151, Tax Code, and distributed consistent with the
- 16 procedures in place for the emergency services fee in Section
- 17 771.0711, Health and Safety Code. A seller may deduct and retain
- 18 two percent of prepaid wireless 9-1-1 emergency services fees that
- 19 it collects under this section to offset its costs in administering
- 20 this fee. Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter,
- 21 the fee under this subsection is the only 9-1-1 emergency services
- 22 fee that applies under this subchapter to a prepaid wireless
- 23 telecommunications service.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
