Subchapter A, Chapter 42, Education Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 42.010 to read as follows: Sec. 42.010. PROHIBITION AGAINST USE OF FUNDING TO SUE 8 9 STATE. (a) A school district that receives state funding under the Foundation School Program may not use that funding or local ad 10 valorem tax revenue to pay the costs of the district's 11 participation in a lawsuit against the state alleging that the 12 state is in violation of the state's obligations under Section 1, 13 Article VII, <u>Texas Constitution</u>. 14 (b) The commissioner may require a school district 15 16 participating in a lawsuit described by Subsection (a) to provide the commissioner with documentation considered sufficient by the 17 commissioner to establish that the district is not in violation of 18 19 Subsection (a). 20 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, the commissioner may withhold state funding to which a district is 21 otherwise entitled under this chapter or Chapter 46 if the 22 23 commissioner determines that the district is in violation of Subsection (a). Subject to the General Appropriations Act, the 24

1	commissioner may use funding withheld under this subsection to pay
2	costs incurred by the agency as a result of the lawsuit described by
3	Subsection (a) in which the district is participating.
4	SECTION 2. Section 42.010, Education Code, as added by this
5	Act, applies only to state funding provided to a school district
6	under the Foundation School Program or local ad valorem tax revenue
7	collected by a school district on or after the effective date of
8	this Act.

9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
