A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to a study by the Legislative Budget Board of the
- 3 feasibility of preparing an impact statement regarding the effects
- 4 of certain proposed legislation on a political subdivision.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "political
- 7 subdivision" includes a county, municipality, school district,
- 8 junior college district, hospital district, or other special
- 9 district.
- 10 SECTION 2. STUDY REGARDING POLITICAL SUBDIVISION IMPACT
- 11 STATEMENT. The Legislative Budget Board shall study the
- 12 feasibility of estimating, and preparing a statement regarding, the
- 13 impact of any bill or resolution being considered by the
- 14 legislature on the distribution of funding and liabilities between
- 15 this state and political subdivisions of this state, if the bill or
- 16 resolution proposes to:
- 17 (1) increase or decrease the funding available to a
- 18 political subdivision; or
- 19 (2) affect the responsibilities or liabilities of a
- 20 political subdivision.
- 21 SECTION 3. REPORT. Not later than December 1, 2014, the
- 22 Legislative Budget Board shall report the results of the study to
- 23 the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of
- 24 representatives, and each member of the legislature.

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- 1 SECTION 4. EXPIRATION. This Act expires January 1, 2015.
- 2 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 3 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 4 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 5 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 6 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
