Section 656.049, Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 15 Sec. 656.049. AUTHORITY TO CONTRACT. (a) A state agency 16 may contract with another state, local, or federal department, 17 agency, or institution, including a state-supported college or 18 19 university, to train or educate its administrators and employees or 20 may join in presenting a training or educational program. 21 (b) A state agency may not contract with a private person to train or educate a state agency administrator or employee if the 22 agency is required under Section 656.050 to use an institution of 23 higher education to provide the training or education. 24

2	amended by adding Section 656.050 to read as follows:
3	Sec. 656.050. TRAINING PROVIDED BY INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
4	EDUCATION. (a) A state agency shall use an institution of higher
5	education to provide training or education to its administrators
6	and employees if the institution can provide the training or
7	education:
8	(1) at a comparable level of quality but at a lower
9	cost to the agency;
10	(2) on the subject matter required by the state
11	agency;
12	(3) in the geographic area in which the state agency
13	administrator or employee is located;
14	(4) not later than the date the agency requires the
15	training or education to be completed; and
16	(5) according to a schedule acceptable to the agency.
17	(b) A state agency may use an institution of higher
18	education to supplement or enhance the training or education
19	provided by full-time state agency employees to the agency's other
20	employees.
21	SECTION 4. Section 656.049, Government Code, as amended by
22	this Act, applies only to a contract entered into on or after the
23	effective date of this Act. A contract entered into before the
24	effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the
25	contract was entered into, and the former law is continued in effect
26	for that purpose.
27	SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
