- 2 relating to the eligibility of certain persons for the supplemental
- 3 nutrition assistance program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 33, Human Resources Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 33.018 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 33.018. EFFECT OF NONCOMPLIANCE WITH WORK REQUIREMENTS
- 8 ON SNAP ELIGIBILITY. If an individual who is the head of household
- 9 becomes ineligible for supplemental nutrition assistance benefits
- 10 for failing to comply with the employment or employment and
- 11 training program requirements in 7 U.S.C. Section 2015(d)(1)(A),
- 12 the department may not deny those benefits to the other eligible
- 13 <u>household members for that reason.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to a determination of eligibility of a person for supplemental
- 16 nutrition assistance benefits made on or after the effective date
- 17 of this Act. A determination of eligibility made before the
- 18 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 19 date the determination was made, and the former law is continued in
- 20 effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 22 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 23 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 24 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or

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- 1 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 2 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
