- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1702.021(a), Occupations Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The Texas Private Security Board consists of nine
- 7 [seven] members appointed by the governor with the advice and
- 8 consent of the senate as follows:
- 9 (1) $\underline{\text{five}}$ [four] public members, each of whom is a
- 10 citizen of the United States;
- 11 (2) one member who is licensed under this chapter as a
- 12 private investigator;
- 13 (3) one member who is licensed under this chapter as an
- 14 alarm systems company; [and]
- 15 (4) one member who is licensed under this chapter as
- 16 the owner or operator of a guard company; and
- 17 (5) one member who is licensed under this chapter as a
- 18 <u>locksmith</u>.
- 19 SECTION 2. Not later than February 1, 2015, the governor
- 20 shall appoint the members of the Texas Private Security Board
- 21 necessary to ensure that the composition of the board complies with
- 22 Section 1702.021, Occupations Code, as amended by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
