- 5 (d) A drain cleaner may:
- 6 (1) install cleanouts and remove and reset p-traps to
- 7 <u>eliminate obstructions in building drains and sewers; and</u>
- 8 (2) advertise and offer to perform or provide drain
- 9 cleaning services as described by Subdivision (1).
- 10 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 11 services performed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 12 Services performed before the effective date of this Act are
- 13 governed by the law in effect on the date the services were
- 14 performed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
