8	Sec. 398.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
9	(1) "General academic teaching institution" has the
10	meaning assigned by Section 61.003, Education Code.
11	(2) "Grant program" means the Texas native seed
12	competitive grant program implemented under Section 398.002.
13	(3) "Native seed" means a seed derived from a plant in
14	a particular region or ecosystem native to this state not later than
15	the 16th century.
16	Sec. 398.002. COMPETITIVE GRANT PROGRAM. (a) The
17	department shall design and implement a competitive grant program
18	for general academic teaching institutions to support the
19	development of native seeds for restoration of wildlife habitat,
20	roadsides, and energy exploration sites.

- 5 desired program results and descriptions of program beneficiaries;
- 6 (2) establish statewide evaluation criteria to
- 7 document grant recipient compliance with grant conditions;
- 8 (3) monitor compliance with the evaluation criteria
- 9 described by Subdivision (2) by gathering, maintaining, and
- 10 analyzing comprehensive data on grant program activities;
- 11 (4) analyze the extent to which the grant program
- 12 achieves the goals developed under Subdivision (1), using either
- 13 empirical or nonempirical evidence; and
- 14 (5) publish the analysis required by Subdivision (4)
- 15 on the department's Internet website or in any annual publication
- 16 the department is required by statute to publish.
