- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 2054, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 2054.1264 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2054.1264. POSTING OF COST-EFFICIENCY SUGGESTIONS AND
- 8 IDEAS ON STATE AGENCY WEBSITE. (a) In this section, "state
- 9 agency" does not include an institution of higher education, as
- 10 defined by Section 61.003, Education Code.
- 11 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (d), each state agency
- 12 that has 1,500 or more employees shall post on the agency's intranet
- 13 website or generally accessible Internet website an electronic form
- 14 or link allowing an employee of the agency to submit suggestions and
- 15 ideas on how to make the agency more cost-efficient.
- 16 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), each state agency
- 17 shall post on the agency's generally accessible Internet website a
- 18 link allowing members of the public to:
- (1) monitor, in real time or on a weekly or monthly
- 20 basis, submissions made under Subsection (b); and
- 21 (2) vote for the public's favorite submission.
- 22 (d) The department may exclude from the requirements of this
- 23 section a state agency if the agency has a preexisting program or
- 24 link that the department determines substantially meets the

- 1 requirements of this section.
- 2 <u>(e) The department shall adopt rules establishing</u>
- 3 procedures and required formats for implementing this section.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
