A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to a database of employers convicted of certain offenses
- 3 involving wage theft.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 301, Labor Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 301.070 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 301.070. DATABASE REGARDING WAGE THEFT. (a) In this
- 8 <u>section</u>, "employee" and "employer" have the meanings assigned by
- 9 Section 61.001.
- 10 (b) The commission shall make available on its Internet
- 11 website a publicly accessible list of all employers in this state
- 12 that have been convicted of an offense under:
- (1) Section 61.019; or
- 14 (2) Section 31.04, Penal Code, if the offense involved
- 15 the theft of a service that was rendered by an employee of the
- 16 employer.
- 17 (c) For an employer that is a business entity, the database
- 18 must include the name under which the entity operates and the name
- 19 of each individual who is an owner of the entity.
- 20 <u>(d) The commission shall list an employer in the database</u>
- 21 until the third anniversary of the date of the conviction described
- 22 by Subsection (b).
- SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2013, the Texas
- 24 Workforce Commission shall establish the database required by

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- 1 Section 301.070, Labor Code, as added by this Act.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
