The assessment 10 11 must include: 12 (1) a screening for trauma; and 13 (2) interviews with individuals who have knowledge of the child's needs. 14 15 (b) The department shall develop: 16 (1) a schedule of approved assessment tools that may be used in the performance of an assessment; and 17 18 (2) guidelines regarding the contents of an assessment 19 report.
