## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 1101, Occupations Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter R to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER R. MULTIPLE-LISTING SERVICES
8	Sec. 1101.851. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
9	(1) "Energy Star rating" is the Energy Star rating
10	under the energy performance rating system for products, homes, and
11	buildings developed by the United States Environmental Protection
12	Agency and the United States Department of Energy.
13	(2) "Home energy rating" means the energy rating of a
14	home under:
15	(A) a home energy rating system developed under
16	Chapter 388, Health and Safety Code, or by a municipally owned
17	utility; or
18	(B) the Mortgage Industry National Home Energy
19	Rating Systems Standards developed by the National Association of
20	State Energy Officials and the Residential Energy Services Network.
21	(3) "ICC 700 rating" is the residential green building
22	rating under the ICC 700 National Green Building Standard developed
23	by the National Association of Home Builders and the International
24	Code Council.

- "LEED rating or certification" means the green 1 building rating or certification under the Leadership in Energy and 2 Environmental Design green building rating and certification 3 system developed by the United States Green Building Council. 4 5 (5) "Multiple-listing service" means a database owned or operated by a person or group of persons licensed under this 6 7 chapter that allows license holders representing sellers to share information regarding properties that are for sale with other 8 license holders. 9 (6) "Residential real property" means property that 10 has a single-family or multifamily dwelling. 11 12 Sec. 1101.852. ENERGY EFFICIENCY INFORMATION. multiple-listing service that lists for sale residential or 13 14 commercial real property must include a field for providing 15 information related to energy use or efficiency of a residence or 16 building on the property. 17 Sec. 1101.853. SELLER'S DISCLOSURE OF CERTAIN ENERGY EFFICIENCY INFORMATION. On request of a seller of residential or 18 commercial real property, a license holder shall include in the 19 multiple-listing service listing of the property information 20 related to the energy use or efficiency of a residence or building 21 on the property, including the residence's or building's: 22 23 (1) Energy Star rating;

(2) home energy rating;

(3) ICC 700 rating; or
