A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1
2 relating to the creation of the Montgomery County Municipal Utility
3 District No. 136; granting a limited power of eminent domain;
4 providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to impose
5 assessments, fees, or taxes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws
8 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 8433 to read as follows:

9 CHAPTER 8433. MONTGOMERY COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 136

10 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

11 Sec. 8433.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

12 (1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.

13 (2) "Commission" means the Texas Commission on
14 Environmental Quality.

15 (3) "Director" means a board member.

16 (4) "District" means the Montgomery County Municipal
17 Utility District No. 136.

18 Sec. 8433.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a
19 municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI,
20 Texas Constitution.

21 Sec. 8433.003. CONFIRMATION AND DIRECTORS' ELECTION
22 REQUIRED. The temporary directors shall hold an election to
23 confirm the creation of the district and to elect five permanent
24 directors as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.

1 Sec. 8433.004. CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. The
2 temporary directors may not hold an election under Section 8433.003
3 until each municipality in whose corporate limits or
4 extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located has
5 consented by ordinance or resolution to the creation of the
6 district and to the inclusion of land in the district.

7 Sec. 8433.005. FINDINGS OF PUBLIC PURPOSE AND BENEFIT. (a)
8 The district is created to serve a public purpose and benefit.

9 (b) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of:

10 (1) a municipal utility district as provided by
11 general law and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution; and

12 (2) Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, that
13 relate to the construction, acquisition, or improvement of
14 macadamized, graveled, or paved roads described by Section 54.234,
15 Water Code, or improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of
16 those roads.

17 Sec. 8433.006. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The
18 district is initially composed of the territory described by
19 Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter.

20 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
21 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the
22 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
23 does not affect the district's:

24 (1) organization, existence, or validity;

25 (2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes
26 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and
27 interest on a bond;

1 (3) right to impose a tax; or

2 (4) legality or operation.

3 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

4 Sec. 8433.051. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is
5 governed by a board of five elected directors.

6 (b) Except as provided by Section 8433.052, directors serve
7 staggered four-year terms.

8 Sec. 8433.052. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) On or after the
9 effective date of the Act enacting this chapter, the owner or owners
10 of a majority of the assessed value of the real property in the
11 district may submit a petition to the commission requesting that
12 the commission appoint as temporary directors the five persons
13 named in the petition. The commission shall appoint as temporary
14 directors the five persons named in the petition.

15 (b) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:

16 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under
17 Section 8433.003; or

18 (2) the fourth anniversary of the effective date of
19 the Act enacting this chapter.

20 (c) If permanent directors have not been elected under
21 Section 8433.003 and the terms of the temporary directors have
22 expired, successor temporary directors shall be appointed or
23 reappointed as provided by Subsection (d) to serve terms that
24 expire on the earlier of:

25 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under
26 Section 8433.003; or

27 (2) the fourth anniversary of the date of the

1 appointment or reappointment.

2 (d) If Subsection (c) applies, the owner or owners of a
3 majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district
4 may submit a petition to the commission requesting that the
5 commission appoint as successor temporary directors the five
6 persons named in the petition. The commission shall appoint as
7 successor temporary directors the five persons named in the
8 petition.

9 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

10 Sec. 8433.101. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has
11 the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for
12 which the district is created.

13 Sec. 8433.102. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND
14 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the
15 general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code,
16 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59,
17 Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

18 Sec. 8433.103. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. (a) Under
19 Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may
20 design, acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve, and
21 convey to this state, a county, or a municipality for operation and
22 maintenance macadamized, graveled, or paved roads described by
23 Section 54.234, Water Code, or improvements, including storm
24 drainage, in aid of those roads.

25 (b) The district may exercise the powers provided by this
26 section without submitting a petition to or obtaining approval from
27 the commission as required by Section 54.234, Water Code.

1 Sec. 8433.104. APPROVAL OF ROAD PROJECT. (a) The district
2 may not undertake a road project authorized by Section 8433.103
3 unless:

4 (1) each municipality or county that will operate and
5 maintain the road has approved the plans and specifications of the
6 road project, if a municipality or county will operate and maintain
7 the road; or

8 (2) the Texas Transportation Commission has approved
9 the plans and specifications of the road project, if the state will
10 operate and maintain the road.

11 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (a), the district is
12 not required to obtain approval from the Texas Transportation
13 Commission to design, acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for,
14 improve, or convey a road project.

15 Sec. 8433.105. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT ORDINANCE
16 OR RESOLUTION. The district shall comply with all applicable
17 requirements of any ordinance or resolution that is adopted under
18 Section 54.016 or 54.0165, Water Code, and that consents to the
19 creation of the district or to the inclusion of land in the
20 district.

21 SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

22 Sec. 8433.151. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS. (a) The
23 district may issue, without an election, bonds and other
24 obligations secured by:

25 (1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes; or

26 (2) contract payments described by Section 8433.153.

27 (b) The district must hold an election in the manner

1 provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval
2 before the district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds
3 payable from ad valorem taxes.

4 (c) The district may not issue bonds payable from ad valorem
5 taxes to finance a road project unless the issuance is approved by a
6 vote of a two-thirds majority of the district voters voting at an
7 election held for that purpose.

8 Sec. 8433.152. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If
9 authorized at an election held under Section 8433.151, the district
10 may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable property in
11 the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water Code.

12 (b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not
13 exceed the rate approved at the election.

14 Sec. 8433.153. CONTRACT TAXES. (a) In accordance with
15 Section 49.108, Water Code, the district may impose a tax other than
16 an operation and maintenance tax and use the revenue derived from
17 the tax to make payments under a contract after the provisions of
18 the contract have been approved by a majority of the district voters
19 voting at an election held for that purpose.

20 (b) A contract approved by the district voters may contain a
21 provision stating that the contract may be modified or amended by
22 the board without further voter approval.

23 SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS

24 Sec. 8433.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER
25 OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations
26 payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees,
27 revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district money, or any

1 combination of those sources, to pay for any authorized district
2 purpose.

3 Sec. 8433.202. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district
4 issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the
5 board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing
6 direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all
7 or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner
8 provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code.

9 Sec. 8433.203. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of
10 issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations
11 issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad
12 valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the
13 real property in the district.

14 SECTION 2. The Montgomery County Municipal Utility District
15 No. 136 initially includes all the territory contained in the
16 following area:

17 Being a 302.00 acre (13,155,064 square feet) parcel situated
18 in the John M. Smith Survey, Abstract 533 and the John Foster
19 Survey, Abstract 205, Montgomery County, Texas, being all of a
20 called 292.0 acre tract conveyed to Lakes At Mill Creek, L.P. by
21 General Warranty Deed recorded under Clerk's File No. 2006-092982
22 of the Official Public Records of Real Property, Montgomery County,
23 Texas, all of a called 10.0088 acre tract conveyed to Lakes at Mill
24 Creek, L.P. by Deed recorded under Clerk's File No. 2009-010587 of
25 the Official Public Records of Real Property, Montgomery County,
26 Texas, containing Unrestricted Reserve "A", Unrestricted Reserve
27 "B" and Unrestricted Reserve "C" of Silverado Ranches according to

1 the map or plat recorded under Cabinet G, Sheet 135 of the Map
2 Records of Montgomery County, Texas, said 302.00 acre parcel more
3 particularly described by metes and bounds as follows with all
4 bearings referenced to the Texas State Plane Coordinate System,
5 Central Zone;

6 BEGINNING, at a concrete monument found for the most easterly
7 corner of a called 2,420.0166 acre tract conveyed to Terra
8 Investments, L.P. by Special Warranty Deed recorded under Clerk's
9 File No. 2004-023496 of the Official Public Records of Real
10 Property, Montgomery County, Texas, for an interior corner of said
11 292.0 acre tract, and the herein described parcel, from which a
12 1-inch iron pipe found bears South 66°05'10" East, 23.42 feet;

13 THENCE, North 47°33'32" West, 2965.11 feet along the
14 northeasterly line of said 2,420.0166 acre tract, and a
15 southwesterly line of said 292.0 acre tract to a 5/8-inch iron rod
16 found in the southeasterly line of a called 44.3605 acre tract
17 conveyed to L. Frankie Hughes by Warranty Deed recorded under
18 Clerk's File No. 9342675 of the Official Public Records of Real
19 Property, Montgomery County, Texas, for the northerly most corner
20 of said 2,420.0166 acre tract, a southwesterly corner of said 292.0
21 acre tract, and the herein described parcel;

22 THENCE, North 48°16'19" East, 115.62 feet along a
23 southeasterly line of said 44.3605 acre tract, and a westerly line
24 of said 292.0 acre tract to a 1/2-inch iron rod found with cap for
25 the most easterly corner of said 44.3605 acre tract, and a
26 southwesterly corner of said 292.0 acre tract, and the herein
27 described parcel;

1 THENCE, North 49°09'16" West, 111.59 feet along the
2 northeasterly line of said 44.3605 acre tract, and a westerly line
3 of said 292.0 acre tract to a 1/2-inch iron rod found for the most
4 southerly corner of Lot 18 of Silverado Ranches according to the map
5 or plat thereof recorded under Cabinet G, Sheet 135 of the Map
6 Records of Montgomery County, Texas, for angle point in the west
7 line of said 292.0 acre tract, and the herein described parcel;

8 THENCE, North 06°38'19" East, 299.51 feet along the east line
9 of said Lot 18, and a westerly line of said 292.0 acre tract to a

24 said Lot 16, and a westerly line of said 292.0 acre tract, to a
25 1/2-inch iron rod found for the southeast corner of said

1 and the herein described parcel;

11 3325.90 feet a 1/2-inch iron rod found for the southwest corner of
12 said Lot 1, and the northwest corner of Lot 2 of said Block 9C,
13 continuing for a total distance of 3746.83 feet to a fence corner
14 found in the west line of Lot 2, Block 10C of said Decker Hills
15 Section 3, for a southeasterly corner of said 292.0 acre tract, and
16 the herein described parcel, beginning a curve to the left;

17 THENCE, along the westerly line of said Lot 2, the westerly
18 line of Lot 3 of said Block 10C, and an easterly line of said 292.0
19 acre tract, along the arc of said curve to the left with a radius of
20 180.00 feet, an arc length of 173.99 feet, through a delta of
21 55°22'54", and a chord bearing South 10°12'26" East, 167.29 feet to a
22 power pole found for a northwesterly corner of said Lot 3, for a
23 southeasterly corner of said 292.0 acre tract, and the herein
24 described parcel;

25 THENCE, South 37°53'53" East, 190.29 feet along the
26 southwesterly line of said Block 10C, and an easterly line of said
27 292.0 acre tract to a fence corner found for the most southerly

1 corner of Lot 4 of said Block C, for the most westerly corner of Lot
2 5 of said Block 10C, for a southeasterly corner of said 292.0 acre
3 tract, and the herein described parcel, beginning a curve to the
4 right;

5 THENCE, continuing along the west line of said Block 10C, and

23 THENCE, North 41°38'57" East, 563.33 feet along the
24 southeasterly line of said 2,420.0166 acre tract, and a westerly
25 line of said 292.0 acre tract to the POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING
26 302.0 acres (13,155,064 square feet) of land in Montgomery County,
27 Texas.

1 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
2 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
3 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
4 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
5 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
6 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
7 Government Code.

8 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
9 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
10 Environmental Quality.

11 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
12 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
13 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
14 representatives within the required time.

15 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
16 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
17 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
18 and accomplished.

19 SECTION 4. (a) If this Act does not receive a two-thirds
20 vote of all the members elected to each house, Subchapter C, Chapter
21 8433, Special District Local Laws Code, as added by Section 1 of
22 this Act, is amended by adding Section 8433.106 to read as follows:

23 Sec. 8433.106. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may
24 not exercise the power of eminent domain.

25 (b) This section is not intended to be an expression of a
26 legislative interpretation of the requirements of Section 17(c),
27 Article I, Texas Constitution.

1 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
5 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
