- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 25.094(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a) An individual commits an offense if the individual:
- 7 (1) is 12 years of age or older and younger than  $\underline{21}$
- 8 [<del>18</del>] years of age;
- 9 (2) is required to attend school under Section 25.085
- 10 or a school district policy adopted under that section; and
- 11 (3) fails to attend school on 10 or more days or parts
- 12 of days within a six-month period in the same school year or on
- 13 three or more days or parts of days within a four-week period.
- 14 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
- 15 25.094, Education Code, apply only to an offense committed on or
- 16 after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before
- 17 the effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect
- 18 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former
- 19 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
