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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the contracting authority of the Texas Historical 3 Commission. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 442.005(o), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (o) The commission may enter into contracts with other state institutions, [and with] qualified private 8 agencies or institutions, and other persons, including for-profit 9 corporations, to carry out the purposes of this chapter. 10 11 SECTION 2. Section 442.0056(b), Government Code, is amended 12 to read as follows: (b) The commission shall restore and maintain each historic 13 site acquired under this section for the benefit of the general 14 public. The commission may enter into interagency contracts and 15 contracts with other persons, including for-profit corporations, 16 17 for this purpose. SECTION 3. Section 442.007(c), Government Code, is amended 18 to read as follows: 19 The commission may enter into contracts or cooperative 20 (c) 21 agreements with the federal government, other state agencies, state or private museums or educational institutions, or qualified 22 23 persons, including for-profit corporations, [individuals] for prehistoric or historic archeological investigations, surveys, 24

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1 excavations, or restorations in this state.

2 SECTION 4. Section 442.0071(c), Government Code, is amended 3 to read as follows:

4 The commission may accept gifts, grants, or other (C) 5 donations on behalf of the Governor's Mansion. The commission shall contract with a nonprofit organization formed to assist in 6 the preservation and maintenance of the Governor's Mansion or with 7 8 a for-profit organization to develop and implement a plan for the solicitation and acceptance of gifts, grants, devises, and bequests 9 10 of money, other property, and services to be used in the acquisition of furnishings, fixtures, works of art, and decorative objects for 11 12 the Governor's Mansion or for necessary landscaping, conservation, or restoration services. The commission also may contract with a 13 nonprofit or for-profit organization described by this subsection 14 15 for the performance of any duty provided by Subsection (b). A contract under this subsection may not exceed a term of two years. 16

SECTION 5. Section 442.072(c), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(c) The commission may enter into an agreement with a nonprofit <u>or for-profit</u> corporation, foundation, association, or other nonprofit <u>or for-profit</u> entity for the expansion, renovation, management, operation, or financial support of a historic site.

23 SECTION 6. Section 442.075(d), Government Code, is amended 24 to read as follows:

(d) On or after the transfer of jurisdiction over a historic
site, the commission may enter into an agreement with a nonprofit or
<u>for-profit</u> corporation, including the Admiral Nimitz Foundation,

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for the expansion, renovation, management, operation, or financial
support of the site.

3 SECTION 7. Section 442.101(b), Government Code, is amended 4 to read as follows:

5 (b) The commission may contract with any appropriate 6 entity<u>, including a for-profit corporation</u>, for services necessary 7 to carry out its responsibilities regarding historic sites 8 described by Subchapter C.

9 SECTION 8. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 10 a contract entered into by the Texas Historical Commission on or 11 after the effective date of this Act.

12 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
